Merit Awards

These scholarships offer students up to 50% of their tuition fees (*up to £16,875*) in the form of a scholarship. These Merit Awards are open to foundation, undergraduate and postgraduate students at Regent's Business School London, undergraduate students at Regent's American College London and to postgraduate students at Webster Graduate School London. They are awarded to students with strong academic achievements and potential.

Work-Study Scholarships

The work/study scholarships are awarded to students with promising academic potential who are able and willing to work for a specified number of hours per week (*from 5 up to a maximum of 20*) during term time in a particular department of the School in return for partial remission of tuition fees.

Students applying for foundation and undergraduate courses at Regent's Business School London, undergraduate courses at Regent's American College London and postgraduate courses at Webster Graduate School London may apply. The work-study scholarships are awarded to students with promising academic potential, who can combine study and work without interfering with their academic progress.

How to apply for a Merit or Work-Study Scholarship

First you must apply to one of our courses. Along with your application form you must send a 500 word statement for the attention of the Scholarship Committee stating why you should be considered for the award and what contribution you feel you will make to the school. The Scholarship Committee will then assess which scholarship you are most suited to and will want to see evidence of academic strength and your potential.

The EBS London International Scholarship

To celebrate the international spirit of EBS London, we award one full scholarship (*covering all tuition fees worth £42,000*) and two half-scholarships (*covering half the tuition fees, each worth £21,000*) for our three and a half year BA (Hons) International Business and BA (Hons) International Events Management degree courses. In response to one of our set questions, a panel of judges from EBS London will be looking for creative and research-based essays. The winning entry should be interesting and thought-provoking and not exceed eight double-spaced pages in length.

Media Communications Scholarships

Media Communication Scholarships are open to undergraduate sophomore or junior Media Communications students demonstrating a strong academic record at either Regent's American College London or a previous institution.

Applicants must submit an article or feature on a pre-set topic. The award is task-based with the holder assuming general editorial responsibility for the campus journal and provides significant editorial content for the duration of the scholarship. The value of the scholarship is up to half the total tuition fees per semester (*up to £2,625*).

All scholarships are subject to the holder maintaining a cumulative GPA (*Grade Point Average*) of at least 3.0 throughout the degree programme.
